



Employment Visa for Crew Members of River Cruise Vessels

Checklist for Filing Your Application

Please read the checklist and fill out the application form thoroughly. We require that the printed and signed checklist is submitted with the application form at your appointment. Please prepare two sets of the listed documents and sort them exactly in the following order:

1	1x Application form	Application completed, printed and signed (including Information provided to applicants pursuant to Section 54 (2) 8 in conjunction with Section 53 of the Residence Act)	☐	
2	Passport + 1 copy of the data page	Valid and signed passport which must have at least two blank pages. It is not mandatory but strongly recommended that the passport is valid for the whole intended stay in Germany.	☐	
3	1x Photo	Recent passport photographs according to biometric specifications (not stapled)	☐	
4	Employment contract + 1 copy <u>or</u> Letter of intent from your future employer + 1 copy	<i>Employment contract:</i> The contract must be signed and contain specific details of the job function, salary and duration of employment. <i>Letter of intent from your future employer:</i> The letter must include details about salary and working hours as well as the full address of the employer.	☐	
5	Questionnaire for Crew Members of River Cruise Ships	See page 3	☐	
6	Guarantee letter from the principal or shipping agent in Germany: + 1 copy	Guarantee letter which confirms that the principal or shipping agent will assume liability in accordance with § 66 to 68 of the AufenthG for the full period of the visa validity. It also has to mention a boarding date NOT earlier than 8 weeks after visa appointment	☐	
7	Invitation letter from the employer	The Invitation letter has to explicitly mention the ship on which the applicant will start working. It has to contain a Declaration from the employer that the ship will not be changed during the visa process or prior to arrival in Germany.	☐

9	Proof of health insurance + 1 copy	If as an employee you are subject to mandatory statutory health insurance, you must bear in mind that this insurance can only begin when you take up residence in Germany and enter into employment. If you enter Germany beforehand, private health insurance must be taken out for the period prior to employment beginning and prior to being eligible for statutory health insurance. In its terms and conditions, travel health insurance can exclude protection if a long-term or permanent stay is planned. So-called incoming travel insurance can also contain such exclusions.	☐

11	Proof of Residence permit in S.A. + 1 copy	Only applicable for non-South African citizens.	☐	
12	1x checklist	Two copies of this checklist have to be signed and submitted with your application.	☐	

The Visa fee amounts to **75 Euro** (if paid by credit card) or the equivalent in ZAR depending on the exchange rate (if paid cash).

The German Mission reserves the right to ask for additional documentation at any time during the processing of the application whenever deemed necessary. Presenting the above-mentioned documentation does not guarantee that the visa will be granted. *We strongly recommend that you do not purchase an airline ticket unless the visa has been approved and the German Mission requests you to do so.*

The processing time can take up to three months, but may be longer in individual cases. Once the application has been approved by the relevant German authority, the German Mission will issue a visa valid for 3 - 6 months (depending on the duration of the travel insurance provided). Your subsequent residence permit will be issued by the competent Aliens Authority in Germany. You are required to apply well in advance for it before the expiry of the visa.
