



Project examples 2024

Lesotho: Hygiene measures in Maseru and Morija

Renovation/new construction of school toilets, especially for girls. Workshops on hygiene and menstrual health were held and awareness-raising measures were introduced at several public schools in Maseru and Morija to improve the overall sanitation infrastructure. These measures restored dignity, privacy, knowledge, and awareness for 1500 students.



Hoedspruit: Promoting the economic independence of women in the processing of plants into oils and cosmetics

Establishment of 40 individual gardens with herbs and provision of permaculture training, ongoing skills development, and mentorship to women to enhance their expertise and knowledge regarding processing of plants into oils and cosmetics. The initiative was set to benefit not only the 40 women directly involved, but also reached out to estimated 200 community members, thereby multiplying the project's positive outcome. This ripple effect will promote economic resilience and foster a culture of sustainability within the village.

Tzaneen: Establishment of a library for the afternoon care of children

Creation of a library for children for afternoon and weekend care and thus overcoming educational deficits and improving social cohesion in rural areas. This project has transformed education and social inclusion in the rural community of Tzaneen. Since the library became operational, over 80 children and adolescents access it daily to benefit from free educational resources, internet services, and psychosocial support. It has become a hub of learning and social engagement, empowering vulnerable children, youth, and their families with opportunities that were previously out of reach.





Further project examples

Lesotho: Development of the first football league for girls' school teams in various age groups, including training for teachers, coaches and supervisors.

Bela-Bela: Installation of a solar system in a children's home to reduce costs and dependence on local electricity providers

Eswatini: Establishment of a training center for female tailors with the purchase of sewing and embroidery machines and provision of workshops in Eswatini

Lesotho: Construction of an additional classroom to increase teaching and learning capacity

Bronkhorstspuit: Improving security in a children's home by repairing an electric fence and purchasing lockers

Eswatini: Refurbishment of an existing dip tank and construction of a storage facility for the chemicals to be used
